One of the most enjoyable and rewarding aspects of being a community pharmacy group is the opportunity to give back to our local communities. Capital Chemist developed a community programme to lend a helping hand to those organisations and individuals in real need of financial assistance. Since the inception of the Community Programme it is estimated that we have donated somewhere between four and five million dollars and helped over 42 local and national organisations as well as needy individuals.

We have made a big difference to adults and children with disabilities by supporting Hartley Lifecare, the Special Children's Christmas Party and Sailability. Our support has aided programmes in schools for Menslink, specialised equipment for Cerebral Palsy, Capital Chemist College scholarships, upkeep of a horse for Pegasus, financial assistance to Rise Above (formerly the Cancer Support Group), equipment for the Neonatal Intensive Care Foundation, a safe sleeping programme for Red Nose and telephone lines for Lifeline, plus many sporting organisations including Netball, Little Athletics, Football/Soccer, Hockey and Little Nippers just to name a few.
